





WORKSHOP ON THE UNIVERSITY FORESTRY EDUCATION AT THE AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA, TBILISI AND AT THE MENDEL UNIVERSITY IN BRNO, CZECH REPUBLIC October 23rd to 28th 2016 at the Faculty of Forestry and Wood Technology, Mendel University in Brno, Czech Republic

At the workshop, the participating experts (university educators), from the Georgia as well as from the Czech Republic, have an opportunity to share information on the on ways and during university forestry education in relevant countries — and discuss ways forwards in addressing the problems. All participants agreed that possible measures can to be taken to address the challenges for making forestry education better and more attractive.

Responding to this possibility, the Faculty of Forestry and Wood Technology, Mendel University in Brno, Czech Republic has considered it pertinent to convene a for-day workshop for university experts and small group of students involved in field working by project Forest Inventory and Sustainable Forestry Management Planning in the Protected Areas of Tusheti Region, Georgia.

The objectives of the envisaged workshop session are:

- a) To further built relations between collegiate experts working on the forestry university education and research with a view to encourage regional approaches to make forestry education in Georgia more attractive.
- b) To engage university experts in discussions of responses to the immediate needs and encourage the development of long-term strategies in to the university forestry education in Georgia.
- c) To propose a basic framework for the promotion of the university forestry education project the following year (focusing to the courses/subjects, summer schools, master's and bachelor's thesis, etc.).

The working language of the workshop will be English and Russian.
